

This website includes everything from letters & sounds to reading full sentences. Available as an app as well.




This website includes content to help with the learning fundamentals: reading, math, shapes & phonics. App available.

This website includes animated stories, songs & rhymes. Each comes with online and offline activities on the themes.




This game focuses on letter recognition while using students' memory. They match initial letters with pictures, playing with/without a timer.

This game focuses on practicing to identify beginning letter & short-and long-vowel sounds through a simple, fun interactive platform.




This games focuses on letter sounds by students combining letters to form words for pictures. Words are read aloud, reinforcing letter sounds.




This game focuses on developing speaking and listening skills, as well as connecting visual text with the printed word.




This website includes 70+ reading games with many providing instant rewards, such as video clips or more fun games.

This website is a great vocabulary building site where, using interactive books, words morph into the objects they name.




This website includes 600+ interactive and engaging learning games to help develop reading, writing and math skills.
